



I have participated in English Recitation Contest. I love this event because it motivated me to practice on my speaking skill. I hope that there will be more events such as this kind.





Wham! We all jumped and turned to the hotel. "The hotel door and windows are wide open!" Carl cried. "Let's check it out," I shouted.






### Aesop's Fables: The Hare and the Tortoise




